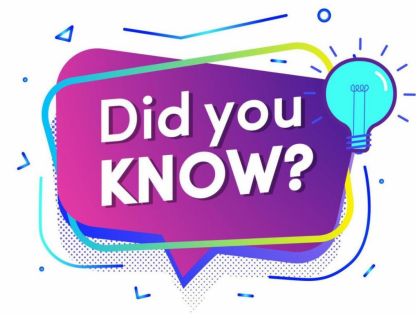

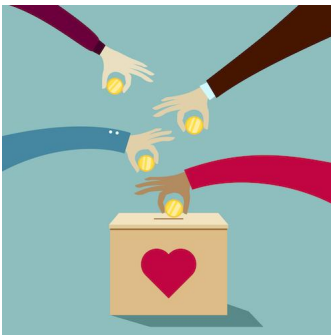

## **2025-2026 Budget and Membership Fees**

There will be two RTAM budget's provided for review and vote at this Fall's AGM. One budget will be based off of the Education Community Membership not passing, and will show an immediate reduction in revenues and spending by 20%. An alternate budget showing increases to membership revenues and ASA revenues will also be provided should the Education Community Membership pass. Both budgets will be online for review before the end of October.
