MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY



There are four types of RTAM Membership:

- Full Membership on a TRAF Pension (most of you)
- Full Membership without TRAF Pension (private/deferred)
- Associate Membership (survivors/other jurisdictions)
- Education Community Membership (NEW: other educational workers)

More detail in the next 4 slides, which we will skip for now.





- RTAM FULL Membership (on a <u>TRAF Pension</u>)
- A certified teacher with five years of teaching experience in Manitoba in receipt of a pension from TRAF;
- RTAM FULL Membership (non-TRAF Member)
- A retired Manitoba-certified teacher with five years of teaching experience in Manitoba who is not eligible to receive a pension from TRAF.

*Teachers who have retired from an independent or private school, would apply with this application form, as would public school teachers who are retiring, but deferring their pension to a later date.





RTAM ASSOCIATE Membership

- An Educator, resident in Manitoba, who receives a pension from a teacher's fund in a Canadian jurisdiction outside of Manitoba;
- An Educator receiving a Manitoba Civil Service Superannuation Fund (CSSF) pension, or resident in Manitoba and in receipt of an equivalent pension from a Canadian jurisdiction outside of Manitoba;
- A non-Educator in receipt of a TRAF pension;
- A person who holds a teaching certificate, who is not retired, who is contributing to TRAF, the CSSF, or its equivalent in a Canadian jurisdiction, and who is a member of the RTAM Long Term Care-Plan;





RTAM ASSOCIATE Membership Application - continued

A person who is not retired, who is contributing to a Manitoba university or college pension fund, or its equivalent in a Canadian jurisdiction outside of Manitoba, and is a member of the RTAM Long Term Care Plan;

The spouse/partner of a full or associate member, or

The surviving spouse/partner of a full or associate member.





Education Community Membership

An individual who has worked within a school, college, university, or education learning facility within Manitoba as part of the education community for a minimum of 5 years;

Education Community members are not voting members of RTAM and as such may not vote on formal matters of RTAM business or take a position with the RTAM Board of Directors.

Any person qualified for such membership shall become an Education Community Member upon payment of the set membership fee.

RTAM FEES

The current annual membership fee is \$36 per year. (\$48/year starting July 1, 2025)

- Members receiving a TRAF pension can opt to have \$3.00 deducted monthly from their TRAF pension for RTAM membership dues. (\$4 starting July 1, 2025)
- Members not receiving a TRAF pension pay \$36 (\$48 as of July 1, 2025) at the time of joining and then annually on July 1st. Invoices are forwarded from the RTAM office directly.
- *Fee amount is subject to change.
- *Please note that RTAM fees are not considered professional fees and are therefore not tax deductible on your income tax.



FINANCE CONSIDERATIONS

- ★Debt is easier to pay down when fully employed; being debt-free in retirement is wonderful!
- ★Consider using a Financial Advisor, preferably one with a fiduciary obligation to you.
- Moving? Second home? Downsizing? Consider all costs.
- ★Make a budget: what are your current ongoing expenses, and will your retirement income cover them? Include savings. Try it for a couple of months!
- ★Choose a health care plan that meets your needs and considers personal and family history. Coverage and deductibles count!
- ★Compare travel insurance: exams, existing conditions, coverage, length of travel deductibles, cost.

RETIREMENT INCOME



- \$ TRAF Pension: request quotes. Not fully indexed.
- \$ Savings and Investments, RRSP's, TFSA's, RRIF's
- \$ Other Pension Plans from previous careers
- \$ CPP (Canadian Pension Plan): bridge? 60? 70? Fully indexed.
- \$ OAS (Old Age Security): bridge? 65? (\$727.67) 75? (\$800.44) Fully indexed. Clawbacks at \$148K and up.
- \$ Work/Entrepreneurship: Now may be the time!

Successful Retirees




- Are physically, mentally, spiritually, socially, and mentally involved


